

SCHOBER'S APPLES

| Variety (by harvest date) | Approximate Harvest | Description | Uses |
|---------------------------|---------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|-------------------------------------------------|
| Pristine | 7/20 | Yellow, tart, keeps well | Eating, cooking |
| Ginger Gold | 8/15 | Yellow, slightly tart, crisp, white flesh | Eating, cooking |
| Gala | 8/25 | Hard, dense, sweet, juicy | Eating, cooking |
| Honeycrisp | 9/1 | Sweet/tart, intense flavor, juicy, crisp | Eating, cooking |
| Red Delicious | 9/15 | Sweet, juicy, aromatic | Primarily eating |
| Cortland | 9/15 | Tart, similar to Macintosh, soft flesh, cooks down well in sauce and baked goods | Eating, cooking, excellent for baking and sauce |
| Empire | 9/25 | Mild, crisp, juicy, excellent all-purpose apple, cross between Mac and Red Delicious | Eating, cooking, great for sauce |
| Rome | 10/1 | Mild, not as juicy | Primarily cooking |
| Golden Delicious | 10/1 | Sweet, juicy, flavorful | Primarily eating |
| Enterprise | 10/10 | Large, hard, tart | Eating, cooking |
| Stayman Winesap | 10/15 | Hard, tart, durable, rough skinned "heirloom" variety with spicy flavor | Eating, cooking, excellent for baking and sauce |
| Fuji | 10/20 | Hard, juicy, very sweet | Primarily eating |
| Gold Rush | 10/25 | Very hard, very tart | Eating, cooking |
| Granny Smith | 10/25 | Hard, tart, juicy | Eating, cooking |
