Variety by harvest date	Approximate harvest date	Description	Uses
Pristine	7/20	Yellow, tart, keeps well	Eating fresh, cooking
Ginger Gold	8/15	Yellow, slightly tart, crisp, white flesh	Eating fresh, cooking
Gala	8/25	Hard, dense, sweet	Eating fresh, cooking
Honeycrisp	9/1	Sweet/tart, intense flavor, juicy, crisp	Eating fresh, cooking
Cortland	9/15	Tart, like MacIntosh, not as hard, cooks down easily	Eating fresh, cooking, excellent for sauce
Red Delicious	9/20	Sweet, juicy, aromatic	Primarily eating fresh
Empire	9/25	Mild, crisp, juicy, all-purpose (cross between Red Delicious and Mac)	Eating fresh, great for baking and sauce
Golden Delicious	10/1	Sweet, juicy, flavorful	Primarily eating fresh
Ludacrisp	10/1	Bold tropical flavor	Primarily eating fresh
Enterprise	10/10	Large, hard, tart	Eating fresh, cooking
Stayman Winesap	10/15	Hard, semi-tart, durable, rough-skinned, "heirloom" variety with spicy flavor	Eating fresh, excellent for baking and sauce
Fuji	10/20	Hard, pink, very sweet, juicy	Primarily eating fresh
Gold Rush	10/25	Very hard, very tart	Eating fresh, cooking
Granny Smith	10/25	Hard, tart, juicy	Cooking, salads
Evercrisp	10/30	Sweet, juicy, crunchy cross between Honeycrisp and Fuji, long-lasting	Eating fresh, cooking
Wild Twist	10/30	Juicy cross between Honeycrisp and Pink Lady	Eating fresh, salads
Pink Lady	10/30	Tart-sweet, dense, juicy	Eating fresh, salads, makes great sauce
